## TradingTop Automated Trading Authorization Agreement

### 1. Purpose Of The Agreement

**1.1 This Automated Trading Authorization Agreement (Hereinafter Referred To As The “Agreement”) Sets Forth The Scope Of Authorization, Rights And Obligations, And Risk Allocation Associated With The Use Of Automated Trading Functionality Provided By TradingTop (Hereinafter Referred To As The “Platform”).**

**1.2 This Agreement Forms An Integral Part Of The Platform's Terms Of Service And Related Legal Documents.**

**1.3 Users Are Required To Carefully Read And Fully Understand This Agreement Before Enabling The Automated Trading Feature.**

### 2. Nature Of Authorization

**2.1 The User Confirms That Enabling Automated Trading Is Done Voluntarily And At Their Sole Discretion.**

**2.2 The User Hereby Authorizes The Platform To Execute Trades Automatically Within The User's Connected Trading Account Based On Predefined System Logic.**

**2.3 Such Authorization Is Strictly Limited To Technical Execution And Does Not Constitute:**

- Investment Advice Or Investment Decision-Making
- Financial Advisory Services
- Asset Management Or Discretionary Portfolio Management
- Custodial Or Fiduciary Trading Arrangements

**2.4 The User Acknowledges That The Platform Does Not Participate In Any Investment Decisions.**

### 3. Scope Of Authorization

**3.1 The User Authorizes The Platform To Perform The Following Actions Within The Connected Trading Account:**

- Order Placement (Opening Positions)
- Order Closure (Including Take-Profit And Stop-Loss)
- Modification Of Order Parameters (E.G., Stop-Loss, Take-Profit)

**3.2 The Authorization Remains Valid Only While The Automated Trading Feature Is Actively Enabled.**

**3.3 The User May Revoke This Authorization At Any Time Through The Platform Interface.**

### 4. Account And Access

**4.1 The User Shall Provide And Manage Their Own Trading Account Credentials, Including But Not Limited To MT4/MT5 Account Details, Server Information, And Trading Passwords.**

**4.2 The User Confirms That:**

- The Account Has Full Trading Permissions (Not Read-Only Access)
- The Use Of Such Account Complies With Applicable Laws And Regulations

#### **4.3 The Platform:**

- Does Not Hold Or Custody User Funds
- Does Not Have Access To Deposit Or Withdrawal Functions
- Does Not Assume Ownership Or Control Of The Account

### **5. Automated Trading Mechanism**

**5.1 Automated Trading Is Executed Based On Algorithmic Logic And System-Generated Outputs.**

#### **5.2 The User Acknowledges That:**

- Trading Strategies Are Determined By System Logic
- Execution Timing And Pricing May Vary
- Optimal Execution Cannot Be Guaranteed

**5.3 Automated Trading Does Not Constitute Any Guarantee Of Returns Or Risk Control.**

### **6. Risk Acknowledgement**

#### **6.1 The User Acknowledges And Accepts The Following Risks:**

- Market Volatility Risk
- Leverage Risk
- Strategy Underperformance Or Failure
- Consecutive Loss Risk
- Technical And System-Related Risks

**6.2 The User Understands That Automated Trading May Result In Substantial Losses Within A Short Period Of Time.**

**6.3 The User Confirms That They Have The Financial Capacity To Bear Such Risks.**

### **7. User Responsibilities**

**7.1 The User Is Solely Responsible For The Security And Management Of Their Trading Account And Funds.**

**7.2 The User Shall Configure Risk Parameters, Including But Not Limited To Maximum Drawdown, Risk Per Trade, And Maximum Concurrent Positions.**

**7.3 The User Is Responsible For Monitoring Account Activity And May Intervene Or Disable Automated Trading At Any Time.**

**7.4 Any Losses Resulting From The User's Failure To Properly Monitor Or Manage Their Account Shall Be Borne Solely By The User.**

### **8. Limitation Of Liability**

**8.1 To The Maximum Extent Permitted By Law, The Platform Shall Not Be Liable For:**

- Any Losses Resulting From Automated Trading
- Strategy Errors Or Model Failures
- Execution Delays Or Slippage
- Third-Party Platform Malfunctions
- Network Or System Failures

#### **8.2 The Platform Does Not Guarantee:**

- Profitability
- Risk Limitation
- Continued Effectiveness Of Strategies

**8.3 The User Acknowledges That All Outcomes Of Automated Trading Are Solely Their Responsibility.**

### **9. Third-Party Platforms**

**9.1 Automated Trading Relies On Third-Party Trading Platforms, Including But Not Limited To Brokers And MT4/MT5 Systems.**

#### **9.2 The Platform Does Not Control Or Guarantee:**

- Execution Quality
- System Stability
- Trading Rules Or Conditions

**9.3 The Platform Shall Not Be Liable For Any Losses Arising From Third-Party Services.**

### **10. Termination Of Authorization**

**10.1 The User May Terminate The Authorization At Any Time.**

#### **10.2 Upon Termination:**

- The System Will Cease Initiating New Trades
- Existing Open Positions Will Not Be Automatically Closed

**10.3 The User Remains Responsible For Managing Any Open Positions.**

### **11. Compliance Statement**

**11.1 The User Is Responsible For Ensuring That The Use Of Automated Trading Complies With Applicable Laws And Regulations In Their Jurisdiction.**

**11.2 The Platform Shall Not Be Liable For Any Consequences Arising From Non-Compliance With Local Laws.**

### **12. Amendments**

**12.1 The Platform Reserves The Right To Update Or Modify This Agreement In Accordance With Business Developments Or Legal Requirements.**

**12.2 Any Updates Shall Take Effect Upon Publication On The Platform.**

**12.3 Continued Use Of Automated Trading Constitutes Acceptance Of The Updated Agreement.**

**13. User Acknowledgement**

**By Enabling Automated Trading, The User Confirms That:**

They Have Read, Understood, And Accepted All Terms Of This Agreement, And Voluntarily Assume All Risks And Outcomes Associated With Automated Trading.
